

Enrollment Criteria

In principle, this program is open to residents of Fukushima Prefecture who are over compulsory school age (age 15 or older by March 31 of the year of enrollment) and who meet one of the criteria on the right.

- (1) Did not graduate from junior high school
- (2) Graduated from junior high school but did not learn sufficiently due to non-attendance or other reasons
- (3) Foreign nationals who did not complete compulsory education in their home country
