

Garbage Sorting and Disposal

Your cooperation in reducing and sorting garbage is appreciated
Please put out your garbage to your designated collection point by 8:30am on each collection day. (DO NOT put garbage out the night before)

Burnable garbage and recyclables will still be collected even if the collection day for your area falls on a public holiday (excluding the End-of-Year & New Year Holidays).

Non-burnables are not be collected on public holidays.

Kitchen Waste

Food scraps, left-over food, vegetable scraps, fish scraps, used tea leaves, eggshells, fruit scraps, seashells, etc.

Paper & Wood Waste

Paper that can't be recycled (paper with stains or a strong odor, thick post cards, items printed with braille, paper cups and plates, handbag or shoe packaging, receipts, delivery docket, shredded paper), disposable diapers, pruned branches etc.

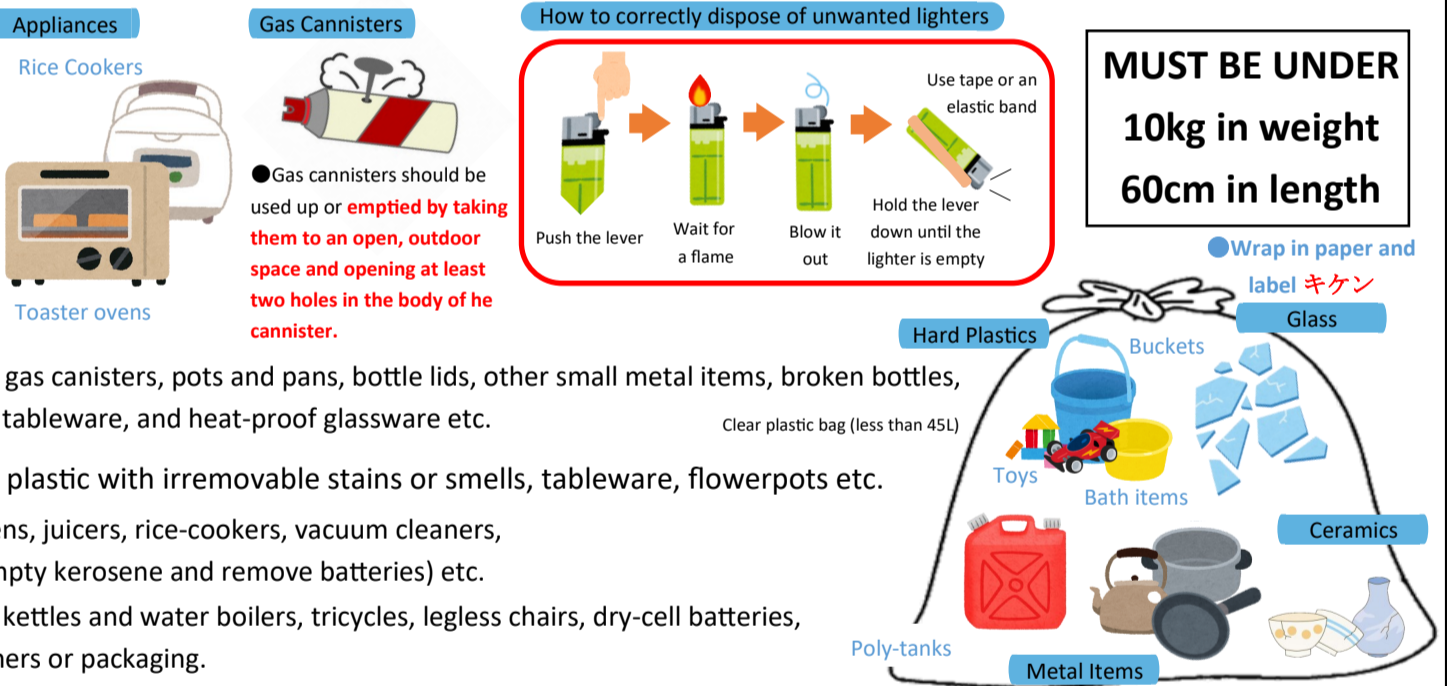
Other

Elastic and rubber items, fabric & clothing, video tape, cassette tape, disposable hand warmers, soft plastic containers and packaging that cannot be cleaned

Non-burnable

collected twice monthly

Metal & Glass

Spray cans, gas canisters, pots and pans, bottle lids, other small metal items, broken bottles, light bulbs, tableware, and heat-proof glassware etc.

Hard Plastic & Ceramics

Toys, hard plastic with irremovable stains or smells, tableware, flowerpots etc.

Small Appliances

Electric ovens, juicers, rice-cookers, vacuum cleaners, heaters (empty kerosene and remove batteries) etc.

Other

Umbrellas, kettles and water boilers, tricycles, legless chairs, dry-cell batteries, oily containers or packaging.

collected 4 times a month

Small Electronics Deposit at collection boxes

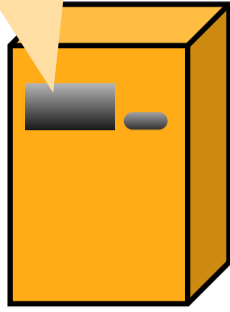
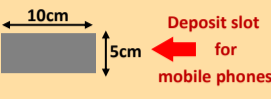
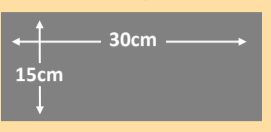
Please deposit directly to collection boxes located in public facilities and private businesses throughout Fukushima City

Items that can be deposited:

*Does not include products that fall under the Home Appliance Recycling Laws (televisions, refrigerators, washing machines, clothes dryers, air conditions etc.) as well as light bulbs, fluorescent tubes, dry batteries or button batteries!!



Items must fit through one of the deposit shoots.



Check before depositing an item

- Please delete all personal information
- You cannot remove an item once it has been deposited
- Please do not leave small household appliances that do not fit into the collection box on top of or nearby the collection box
- If you are not using the collection box, small electronics can be put out as non-burnable garbage (items over 60cm or 10kg should be disposed of as large rubbish). Computers, however, should NOT be put out to collection points. Please enquire with the computers maker or the Computer 3R Promotion Association for more information on how to dispose of your computer.

Please submit an application for separate collection on a designated day (up to 5 items) Please do not put out to your collection point

Household Appliances	Furniture & Storage
Microwaves, de-humidifiers etc.	Tables, shelves, sofas, shoe boxes, wardrobes, organ keyboards etc.
Bedding & Upholstery	Vehicles
Beds, futon mattresses, carpets and rugs etc.	
Other	Bicycles, prams, bicycle trailers, etc.
Skis, snowboards, golf clubs, drying racks and stands etc.	

*Items must be between 60-200cm in length and within 10-100kg in weight.

Items Not Covered by the City's Collection Services

Non-collection Items

Car parts, safes, agricultural equipment or pesticides, construction materials, agricultural plastic sheets, metal regulus, medical waste etc.



Please enquire with the store from which you purchased the item, or request collection from a Collection & Disposal Company

Motorbikes & Electric Bicycles

Manufacturers etc. offer collection and recycling services

Please enquire with a Motorcycle Recycling Dealership or take to the Designated Disposal Point

Appliance Recycling Law

Air-conditioners, Braun-tube televisions, Liquid crystal televisions, plasma televisions, refrigerators, freezers, coolers, wine coolers, washing machines, clothes dryers etc.

Request collection from an appliance store or a Collection & Disposal Company, or drop-off at a Designated Drop-off Location

Business Waste

Waste created in the running of a store, restaurant, office, or agricultural business.

Large Amount of Waste

A large amount of waste created at one time due to moving house etc.

Drop off to a Clean Center (business waste requires a fee and is limited to burnable waste (regular collection waste) only), or enquire with a Collection & Disposal Company
