



宮畑縄文むらとの違いは？

How is it different from the Jomon Village at the Miyahata Site?

Tateanajukyo Pit dwellings buildings and houses were discovered within the fence line of the Minami-suwahara Site, which was a village from almost the same period as the buildings at the Miyahata Site. There were no infant tombs near the buildings, nor were there any giant posts 90cm in diameter.

A village existed with houses and buildings which differed to those at the Miyahata Site.





As there are no infant tombs near those buildings with four or six posts, these buildings are not facilities to send infants to the next world as they were at the Miyahata Site. They are thought to have been used as warehouses and residences.
