

Sorting and Disposal of Recyclables and Garbage

Garbage Sorting App
「さんあーる」 is useful!



- Please sort and place garbage at the designated collection point by **8:30am** on the collection day.
- If the rules are not followed, garbage will not be collected and a **violation sticker** will be attached. It is the responsibility of the person who put the garbage out to take it back and sort it properly.

Recyclable Resources (Recyclables)

① 1st to 4th day 4 times a month
②~⑩ and day 2 times a month

Put out each type in a clear bag (under 45L)

① Plastics



← Items with this mark

- Empty, rinse with water, and remove stains
- ※ Plastic bags can be cut open with scissors, etc.
- If stains cannot be removed, dispose of as Burnable

② Cans



Aluminium and steel cans for food and drink

- Empty and rinse
- Do not need to separate aluminium and steel
- Excludes aerosol cans and cans with stains that cannot be removed (Landfill)

③ Glass



Glass bottles etc. for food & drink (including medication)

- Empty, remove labels and caps, and rinse
- Excludes broken bottles (Landfill)

④ PET Bottles



← Items with this mark

- Empty, remove labels and caps, and rinse
- Dispose of removed labels and caps as ① Plastics

⑤ Dry Cell Batteries



Cylindrical, rectangular, button-shaped, coin-shaped, etc.

- Excludes rechargeable batteries (Small Electronics Collection Box)
- ※ Please insulate with vinyl tape, etc.

Bind each type crosswise with string and put out

⑥ Newspapers & Pamphlets



- If using a newspaper collection bag, seal the bag closed with tape or string
- Height under 40cm

⑦ Magazines & Books

Brochures bound in book form, notebooks, catalogs, etc.



- Remove any plastic coating or attachments
- Height under 40cm

⑧ Cardboard Boxes


Items with a corrugated layer



- Excludes items with wax coating (Burnable)
- Side length under 50cm per side, height under 20cm

⑨ Cartons

← Items with this mark



- Empty and rinse
- Cut open when dry
- Height under 40cm

⑩ Small Paper

Calendars, paper boxes, wrapping paper, envelopes, toilet rolls, etc.



- If putting out in a paper bag, close with tape or string
- Remove handles if not paper
- Height under 40cm

Deposit in Small Electronics Collection Box

① Small Electronics

- Smartphones & mobile phones
- Telephones & fax machines
- Radios & radio cassettes
- Digital audio players
- CD/MD players
- IC recorders
- Game devices
- Laptops & tablets
- Cameras & digital video cameras
- USB memory sticks & SD cards
- Hard disks
- Remote controls
- AC adapters
- Car navigation system
- Cables & chargers, etc.



※Does not include TVs, refrigerators, washing machines, air conditioners, or other appliances that fall under the Home Appliance Recycling Law!
Dispose of Small Electronics that **do not fit in the Collection Box** as Landfill

② Rechargeable Batteries

- Shavers
- Small electric fans
- Portable chargers
- Heated tobacco products
- Rechargeable game consoles
- Rechargeable drills, etc.



※Rechargeable batteries that **do not fit in the Collection Box** or are deformed or swollen should be brought to ① the Waste Policy Division of the City Hall Main Office, or ② a Clean Center


Items with these marks!



Check before depositing in Collection Box

- Please delete all personal information
- Deposited items cannot be removed
- Portable power supplies, car batteries, etc. cannot be deposited

Non-Recyclable Garbage to be Burned (Burnable) Under 60cm and 10kg Every day and day

2 times a week

- Items that do not fall into the categories of Recyclables, Small Electronics/Rechargeable Batteries, or Large Garbage, and are combustible
- Put out in transparent bags under 45L (cardboard boxes, fertilizer bags, etc. are not acceptable)

Pruned Branches

Disposable Diapers

Video Tapes

Rubber & Leather

Clothing & Fabric, etc.

Non-Recyclable Garbage to be Buried (Landfill) Under 60cm and 10kg and day

2 times a month

- Items that do not fall into the categories of Recyclables, Small Electronics/Rechargeable Batteries, or Large Garbage, and are not combustible
- Put out in transparent bags under 45L (cardboard boxes, fertilizer bags, etc. are not acceptable)



Glass

Appliances
(Excluding those under Home Appliance Recycling Law)

Metal Items

Hard Plastics

Ceramics

Aerosol Cans etc.

Large Garbage

Between 60cm to 200cm in length, and 10kg to 100kg in weight

Items That Cannot be Collected by the City

Hazardous or unprocessable items, appliances subject to the Recycling Law, computers, commercial waste, temporary high volume garbage, etc.

■ Car parts, safes, agricultural equipment/pesticides/plastic, building materials, metal ingots, medical waste, etc.

■ Motorbikes (including motorized bicycles)

■ Appliances subject to the Home Appliance Recycling Law

■ Commercial waste

■ Temporary high volume garbage, etc.
