






They worked together to erect posts weighing several tons using ropes made of cane.

It was necessary to dig a large hole to erect the huge posts that were 90cm in diameter.



An experiment in erecting posts by manpower as in the Jomon Hoisting with a crane period (Sakura-machi Site in Toyama Prefecture)





The construction of the foundation on which to place the roof is complete after erecting posts and joining timbers linking posts (beams and cross-beams).

The height of the posts of the restored building are 4m. The highest point of the roof reaches 7.5m. The lifting and joining of the timber when making the roof was also carried out in teams.

Nearby the buildings surrounding the public square, many infants were buried and artifacts for prayer have also been

The buildings are thought to be facilities for giving prayers to send infants to the next world.

It is thought that the building with the huge posts 90cm in \checkmark diameter was a symbolic facility as the center of prayer, having been built with the combined effort of many people. The building was reconstructed without walls, as a facility

While, on one hand, there is the opinion that the building was not used as facility for prayer but as a residence, it was reconstructed without walls, as a facility for prayer.
